AFTERNOON TEA & ENTERTAINMENT

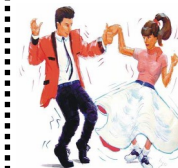
Th Fellowship team are planning another afternoon on fun and fellowship.

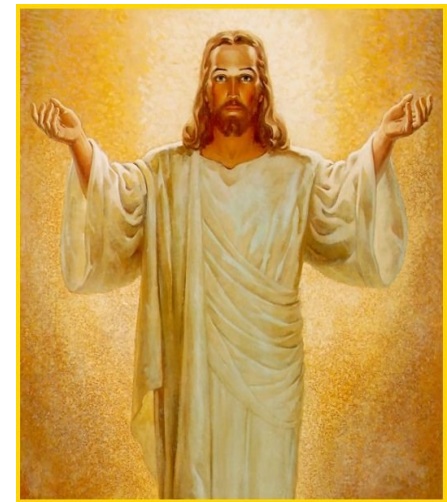
