Our count is now up to **387 Beanies**. We are well on our way to reaching our target of 500 by the end of the Church year at the end of November.



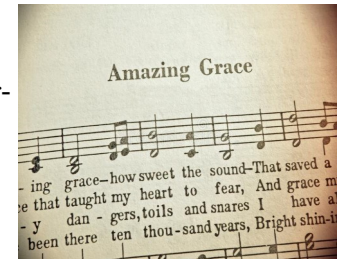
Please leave all items for the seafarers Mission in the basket in the Foyer, ready to be delivered to Lance.
