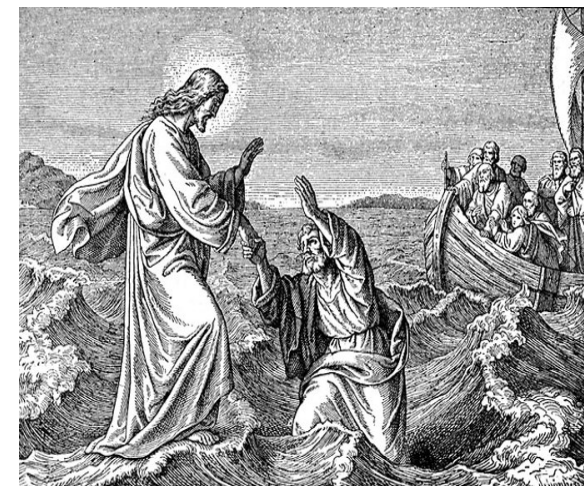

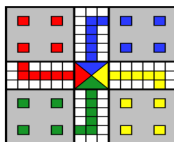

Upper Hutt Housing Trust

The trust was formed as a Christian response to homelessness and our board is made up from parishioners of Upper Hutt Churches.

Currently they lease 31 houses and own one and provide accommodation for over 110 people.

There are so many people they are unable to help. Last Friday alone four people were referred to us but our houses were all full.

The Trust would like to buy good quality aluminium thermal blankets and provide one for each of the people living rough in the bush or their cars. These cost \$80 each.
